## Here are some of the benefits for CIU Alumni ...

### Alumni Guestrooms

As a benefit to all of our alumni, we offer each alumni household one free night per year in one of our alumni guestrooms, compliments of Alumni Ministries. For additional rooms or nights, the per-room benefit charge for alumni is \$25 per night (double occupancy), plus \$5 for each additional person. Non-alumni may also stay in our guestrooms at a charge of \$35 per night (double occupancy), plus \$5 for each additional person. Reservations are handled by CIU's receptionist/hostess, who can be reached by phone at (803) 754-4100, extension 0. (Restrictions: This benefit is non-transferrable [i.e. friends and relatives may not use this benefit in place of the alumnus]. Alumni may only receive one free night per household. Benefit not applicable during Homecoming.)

### Meals

In addition to the free room, alumni may receive three free meals in the dining room per year, compliments of Alumni Ministries. Tickets for meals must be picked up beforehand in the Alumni Office. The cafeteria cannot issue the free alumni meal tickets. (These tickets are for alumni — additional meal tickets can be purchased at a discount in the cafeteria.) CIU alumni can also benefit from discounted prices in the cafeteria: breakfast - \$3.00; lunch - \$3.50; dinner - \$4.00. Call ext. 3278 for the lunch menu recording.

You can use your guest pass for any course up to the level of your highest degree (i.e. an alumnus with a master's degree could use the guest pass for a bachelor or master's course.)

(Restrictions: Permission to guest pass classes with the privilege of free tuition is granted on a space available basis and is subject to audit/guest pass restrictions imposed by our accrediting associations. Tuition-free guest pass privileges do not apply to private music courses, language courses, internships, practicums, extension courses, field education courses and other courses identified as not available for audit.)
