The Financial Aid Office helps you secure the funds necessary to pursue your educational goals through the administration and implementation of federal, state, and institutional financial assistance programs.

#### **Financial Aid Reminders**

- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year at <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u> for the Financial Aid Office to award grants, loans, and need-based scholarships.
- CIU FAFSA school code = 003429.

#### **Important Dates**

- October 1 2017/2018 FAFSA is available
- March 15 CIU Donor Scholarship Deadline
- June 30 FAFSA submission deadline for SC residents receiving SC Tuition Grant

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

- You must be enrolled full time (12 credit hours) in a degree-seeking program to receive CIU scholarships and grants.
- SC Life Scholarship recipients must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA and earn an average of 30 credit hours per academic year.
- Federal loans require a student to be enrolled at least half time (six credit hours) in a degreeseeking program. A change in enrollment status after funds are disbursed may require repayment of all or a portion of your award.



#### STUDENT ACCOUNTING

Student Accounting offers students and authorized users support in meeting their financial obligations.

#### **Paying Your Bill**

- Settlement of all semester charges is due by midnight on the first day of each semester.
- An email notification will be sent to your official CIU email account when the bill is available to view and/or pay on <u>my.ciu.edu</u>. The bill includes the amount due as well as anticipated scholarships, loans, grants, or other financial assistance.
- Pay your bill or set up a payment plan online at my.ciu.edu.

#### **Payment Plan**

- Payment plans are available for the Fall and Spring semesters, breaking each semester into monthly payments with no interest. A new payment plan must be set up each Fall and Spring semester by midnight on the first day of the semester.
- To enroll in a payment plan, log in to my.ciu.edu, select "Student Accounting," and "Sign up for a Payment Plan."

#### **Excess Funds**

- If you are eligible for excess funds, Direct Deposit is required. Submit your bank information on my.ciu.edu, log in, select "Student Accounting," "My Student Account Info," and complete the "Direct Deposit" form before classes begin.
- If you need book vouchers from your excess funds to purchase books prior to classes starting, contact Student Accounting.

Residence Life exists to provide an excellent, oncampus housing experience, and to cultivate a community that fosters deep relationships and spiritual growth in the lives of our students. Living on campus offers many conveniences including easily accessible parking and access to campus buildings, free laundry facilities and Wi-Fi, modern attractive facilities secured by keycards only issued to residents, and a resident assistant on every floor providing information, oversight and activities.

#### **Housing Requirements:**

- Unmarried students under the age of 23 are required to live in the residence halls.
- On-campus residents are required to be enrolled in an academic program.
- Students taking less than a full load are accommodated as space is available and with the permission of the Residence Life Office.
- Resident Curfew (Freshman-Junior): Sunday – Thursday 1 a.m.
   Friday – Saturday 2 a.m.

- Residence hall students have 10, 14, or 21 meals/week options along with \$150 Ram Bucks per semester that can be used in the Dining Hall or Ram Shack by scanning your ID card. Your meal plan is part of your room and board and will show up on your fee statement as "Room and Board."
- Commuter students have 25, 50, or 75 meals/semester options and can be purchased at the Dining Hall office.

#### **Flex Dollars**

Flex Dollars may be added to your ID card to be used in the Dining Hall and Ram Shack. Flex Dollars do not expire and can be added at the Dining Hall Office or online at **ciu.pcconline.net**. For every \$10 purchased, \$11 is added to your account.

The Campus Security Department patrols the campus 24 hours a day, 7 days a week ensuring the safety of the campus. Campus Security locks and unlocks facilities, enforces parking and traffic regulations, and reports all criminal activity, emergencies, and safety issues to the appropriate officials.

#### **Parking**

Parking regulations are enforced to provide safety, convenience, and adequate parking for all CIU community members.

Certain parking spaces are designated and reserved for separate campus groups. Designated parking spaces are marked with paint at the rear of the space and/or with a sign. Undesignated (not marked) parking spaces are available for use by any CIU community member.

#### **Vehicle Registration & Decal**

Students are required to register all vehicles driven/parked on campus within the first week of classes.

**Registration:** Log in to my.ciu.edu and go to the "Student Life" tab to register your vehicle online.

Cost: \$40/year or \$25/semester

**Decal:** Pick up your decal in the Student Life Office located in the lower level of Rossi Student Center.

Free Guest Parking Passes are available from Campus Security for campus visitors and members of the CIU community using a vehicle on campus for two weeks or less.

#### **CIU Alert**

CIU Alert is CIU's emergency alert system, where you can receive alerts via text, email, or both. The alerts include emergency notifications such as tornado warnings, building fires, lockdowns, or weather related school closings. - Complete the Pre-Registration Medical Requirements Form and submit it to Health Services with proof of health insurance coverage before starting classes.
- Keep a copy of your health insurance card in case medical care is needed.

#### **Health Insurance**

You are required to have health insurance coverage under the federal government's health care law (the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act), and are responsible to secure your own coverage.


