PURPOSE: The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to establish the terms and conditions under which the Snowbird Wilderness Outfitters (SWO) will function in relation to Columbia International University (CIU).

COMPATABILITY OF INSTITUTIONAL MISSION:

The mission of CIU is to educate people from a biblical worldview to impact the nations with the message of Christ. This mission is encapsulated in the motto "To know Him and to make Him known."

Snowbird Wilderness Outfitters is a North Carolina non-profit camp located in Andrews, N.C. SWO exists to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ through the exposition of Scripture and personal relationships in order to equip the Church to impact this generation.

At CIU, the educational unit that will implement this agreement is the College of Arts and Sciences (CAS).

SWO agrees to:

Provide an official transcript listing all earned work from SWO. And that all transcribed work will meet the standards agreed upon for workload, semester hour definition, and credentialed faculty.

CIU agrees to:

Transfer as equivalent the following courses (as long as courses are transcribed by SWO and the student has earned a C or better). Transfer will be brought in at full credit as indicated on the transcript by SWO.

Students who participate in this program may be eligible for a renewable Partnership Discount each semester if they are enrolled full-time in CIU's residential undergraduate degree seeking programs or enrolled at least part-time in CIU's online undergraduate or online graduate degree seeking programs.

Prospective students should contact the Admissions Office for details. Current students should contact the Financial Aid Office to ensure continued eligibility for the Partnership Discount.

CIU and SWO will review this policy every five years.

The specific terms of this agreement are as follows:

- This document does not establish an academic partnership but an articulation agreement for the benefit of qualified students.
- This agreement shall be reviewed every five years (unless otherwise noted in agreement and may be cancelled at any time by either institution with appropriate protection for students enrolled in any given semester.
- The agreement may also be amended with the consent of both institutions.
- If there has been no activity for the previous five years, then the program and agreement will be terminated and a review for renewal is not required.
