

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Columbia International University | Technical College of the Lowcountry

Affirmed: 10/2022 To Be Reviewed: 10/2027

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to establish the terms and conditions under which credit earned through completion of the Technical College of the Lowcountry's Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing (ADN) will be applied to Columbia International University's Bachelor of Science in Nursing online program (RN-BSN).

COMPATABILITY OF INSTITUTIONAL MISSION:

The mission of CIU is to educate people from a biblical worldview to impact the nations with the message of Christ. This mission is encapsulated in the motto "To know Him and to make Him known."

The Technical College of the Lowcountry is a comprehensive, multi-campus, two-year public college serving approximately 5,000 students in the four-county service area of Beaufort, Colleton, Hampton, and Jasper counties of South Carolina. College programs and services provide accessible, affordable, quality education that prepares a diverse student population to succeed in the job market, to transfer to four-year colleges and universities, and to achieve their professional and personal goals. The college equitably provides higher education opportunities that stimulate the local economy by generating a world-class workforce and enhancing the social vitality of the community.

At CIU, the educational unit that will implement this agreement is CIU Global.

The Technical College of the Lowcountry (TCL) agrees to:

- (1) Advertise this agreement for TCL constituents:

Columbia International University agrees to:

(2) Admit TCL students to CiU's RN-BSN online program when the following criteria are met:

- (1) Graduate with an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing from TCL.
- (2) Pass the NCLEX-RN and obtain an unrestricted license to practice nursing in South Carolina or the state of their residence (compact state licensure required).
- (3) Online application including completed FAFSA or alternative method of payment
- (4) All official transcripts from all schools attended have been received by the CIU Admissions Office. Only courses with a "C" or better will be transferred.

Students who participate in this program may be eligible for a renewable Partnership Discount each semester if they are enrolled at least part-time in CIU's online undergraduate degree seeking program.

Prospective students should contact the Admissions Office for details. Current students should contact the Financial Aid Office to ensure continued eligibility for the Partnership Discount.

The specific terms of this agreement are as follows:

- This document does not establish an academic partnership but an articulation agreement for the benefit of qualified students.
- This agreement shall be reviewed every five years (unless otherwise noted in agreement and may be cancelled at any time by either institution with appropriate protection for students enrolled in any given semester.
- The agreement may also be amended with the consent of both institutions.
- If there has been no activity for the previous five years, then the program and agreement will be terminated and a review for renewal is not required.
